

WORKSKILLS AND EMPLOYABILITY

This course is targeted at students who are looking to complete vocational qualifications post 16, for example, BTEC First and National Diplomas, NVQ's and Work Based Apprenticeships. It aims to give the students the skills, knowledge and understanding to prepare for working life, now and in the future as confident individuals

The course aims to complement the more traditional GCSE subjects and will help students prepare for employment. In order to complete this course, students will complete 37 credits over 26 assignments. Topics include some of the following:

- Alternatives to paid work
- Managing your own money
- Searching and applying for a job
- Career Options and Progression
- Health and Safety in the Workplace
- Planning and Implementing an Enterprise project
- Employability Skills including communication and teamwork
- Developing Leadership
- Building working relationships
